## Section 4. First aid measures

## Section 5. Fire-fighting measures

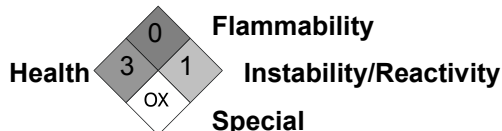
