EFFECTS FROM ACUTE EXPOSURE:

INGESTION: Severe burns to mucous membranes of mouth, throat and digestive tract.

SKIN CONTACT: Prolonged contact causes severe burns which may not be immediately painful or visible. **INHALATION:** Inhalation of mist will irritate mucous membranes. Can cause damage to mucous membranes
